Our Facilities

The school is a brand-new two-storey building with large, bright classrooms and modern facilities. The school will eventually cater for 420 pupils with two classes in each year group.

The school entrance leads to the double-height Learning Resource Centre and Hall which provide large, inviting spaces for lessons and group activities.



The school grounds are extensive and we have a large sports field and a hard surface play area. There are also areas of woodland and wildflower meadows – our children are passionate about the environment and have planned and developed these areas to encourage more species of wildlife to make homes in our grounds.



Our sports premium funding has been used to have colourful activity trails and games created on the playground to encourage children to be active and have fun at playtimes and lunchtimes.

In addition to these, children in the Early Years classrooms have access to a large outdoor area with a range of activities to develop their academic, social and spiritual skills. This outdoor provision continues in KS1, with outdoor access from all classrooms onto a dedicated play area and learning space.

Our Curriculum

Our aim is to develop creative and curious citizens who change and shape the world of today and tomorrow, with respect and understanding for each other and the world around them. Through our learning, we work together to achieve this aim with enjoyment and pride in our achievements.



Our curriculum promotes the social, moral, spiritual, cultural, emotional and physical development of our pupils.

Our lessons are lively and interesting, planned to excite children in their work and inspire a life-long love of learning.

In Early Years, the learning is driven by the interests of the children and our teachers are skilled in identifying each child's next steps to help them to progress across the curriculum. They plan activities and experiences to inspire children to take their own learning further and to develop the characteristics of effective learning – playing and exploring; creating and thinking; active learning.

We teach each subject as a stand-alone subject. We believe that this gives children the opportunity to access the highest quality learning in each subject and enables us to ensure that children have a clear understanding of what it means to be a geographer, historian, artist or musician. We map out high quality units

for each subject each term, ensuring that they build on prior knowledge and enable them to follow a clear progression in skills and knowledge throughout their time at Boorley Park.

For each year group, we identify the core knowledge that children need to learn in each subject and the associated skills they need to be taught and then apply to be effective learners. These are the building blocks for the units of work we teach each term.



In addition to our large, bright classrooms we also have a specialist food technology room to enable pupils to cook with our school chef and a large sports hall with a drama studio attached to enhance our sport, drama and dance provision.

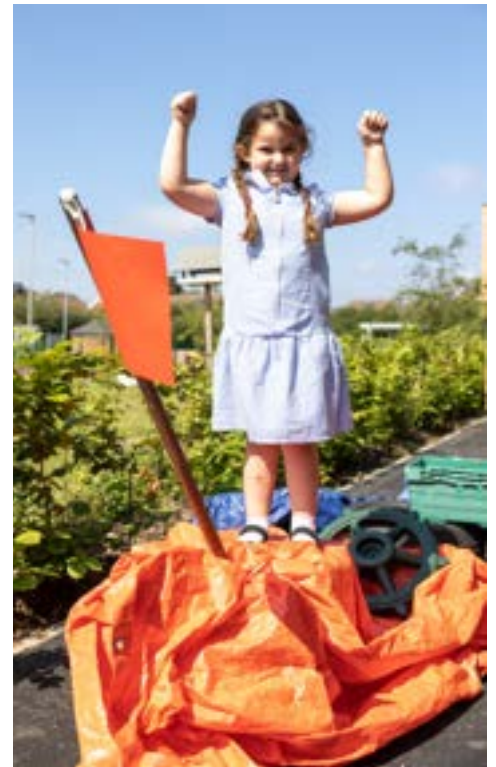
Home, School and Community Partnership
